9 high-performance speakers

- 1 Two 2.5-cm tweeters in the front doors.
- 2 Two 16.8-cm low-mid-range speakers in the front doors.
- 3 Two 13.3-cm low-mid-range speakers in the rear doors.
- 4 Two 6.4-cm mid-high-range speakers in the d-pillars.
- 5 One 13.3-cm high-performance woofer with dual voice coil in a 10-liter vented bass enclosure (Acoustimass®) under the driver seat.

System electronics

- 6 Digital amplifier mounted in the instrument panel. Includes Bose digital signal processing, AudioPilot® noise compensation technology and 6 channels of customised equalisation.
- 7 AudioPilot® microphone in the ceiling-mounted control panel monitors interior noise level.

Each part of the Bose sound system has been carefully engineered to work with the others for better performance. Replacing the factory-installed headunit (i. e. radio-CD/navigation system) or any other sound system component will significantly reduce system performance.
